Results

Giberson Timing will electronically record results until 2:00pm. Finishers after this time will be recorded by hand timing. Unofficial results will be posted at the finish area as soon as they can be processed. If there is a protest it must be loged with the race jury at the finish line before you leave the finish area. Times are recorded in hours, minutes and seconds. Results will be available at the Awards Ceremony and can also be found at www.mccallnordic.com immediately following the race.
